## **RULES FOR THE USE OF THE COLLECTIONS**

Reading room privileges are granted subject to the following conditions, intended to protect collections and to ensure their preservation for future researchers.

- 1. Keep documents in their existing order.
- 2. Photo ID must be presented.
- 3. Sign in daily at the register.
- 4. Only pencils (not pens), laptop computers (not cases), and cameras are allowed in the reading room. Pencils may be borrowed from the front desk.
- 5. Stop for inspection on departure.

Permission to use collections: Access to a collection or publication may be restricted in agreement with the donor or because it is in an exhibit, or is awaiting processing or preservation.

Permission to publish: Researchers must secure written permission from the director of special collections to publish (including on a webpage) materials in our collections. In many cases the Seminary does not own literary or artistic rights and the researcher may have to obtain permission from other sources as well

Security: The reading room and other areas are monitored to prevent theft or misuse of collections.
